
Gloves should be worn when there is a risk of contamination with blood or bodily fluids OR where it is indicated by site policy e.g for transmission-based precautions. 1

Gloves **do not** replace the need for correct and appropriate hand hygiene.

Gloves **must** be changed between patients.

Do not perform hand hygiene while wearing gloves.

Overuse of PPE e.g incorrect glove use can be as dangerous as not wearing PPE at all.
